1. CALL TO ORDER

7. PURCHASE LIGHTBAR AND EMERGENCY LIGHTING FOR NOONDAY C-1

Matt Thiessen made a motion to approve purchasing a lightbar and emergency lighting for Noonday C-1 for \$2,439.24; 2nd by Paul Perryman; motion carried 4-0.

8. PURCHASE CAMPER COVER FOR WHITEHOUSE C-1

Chief Rozell stated that this camper cover will go on the new command truck for Whitehouse VFD. He stated selling the old command truck will put money back into the budget that has been spent on the new command truck. Leroy Biggers made a motion to approve purchasing a camper cover for Whitehouse C-1 for \$2,345.00; 2nd by Paul Perryman; motion carried 4-0.

9. BULK PURCHASE OF PHOS CHEK FOAM

Vice President Wilson stated 3 bids were received for 6 barrels of Phos Chek foam; Rowe CAFS \$5,567.60, MES \$5,941.66, and Metro Fire \$5,728.00. Chief Rozell stated that SCESD2 is down to 1 barrel of Phos Chek foam and it is time to order more. He stated the money will come from 51998

Bulk Purchases. Leroy Biggers made a motion to approve the bulk purchase of Phos Chek foam from Rowe CAFS for \$5,567.60 from 51998 Bulk Purchases; 2nd by Matt Thiessen; motion carried 4-0.

10. REPLACE LOADING RAMP ON BULLARD TRANSPORT-1

Chief Rozell stated that Bullard's Transport-1 has a safety issue, you have to fold down the loading ramp manually and it is not very wide. He stated he had J&D Enterprises come do a quote to replace Bullard VFD Transport-1 loading ramp by mirroring the new SCESD2 Transport truck's hydraulic system. Matt Thiessen made a motion to approve replacing the loading ramp on Bullard VFD Transport-1 for \$4,965.75; 2nd by Leroy Biggers; motion carried 4-0.
